For example, Mr. Park Hang-seo, with his expertise and achievements, was invited to be a coach for the Vietnam National Football Team with a salary of 1.4 billion VND/year and many other benefits.

Vietnam increasingly hosts many domestic and international sporting events, requiring skilled professionals to manage and coordinate these events. For example, in football, there are several job opportunities from high to low levels such as event managers, security staff, maintenance teams, etc.

For example, brand management positions for sports brands such as Biti's, Ananas... in Vietnam with salaries ranging from 20 - 30 million with many incentives according to the company.
